dL4 Term is a small footprint terminal emulator product that offers an alternative to buying a dedicated terminal or expensive terminal emulator.

dL4 Term extends normal character terminal features with a GUI (graphic user interface) oriented terminal model providing multiple windows and graphic controls such as buttons and list boxes. It also supports the display of multiple fonts or graphics in any of the Windows belonging to dL4 Term. When the user is connected via a network to a Unix host, for example, dL4 Term supports shell, vi, IQ, UniBasic and dL4.

GUI programs, written for dL4 for Windows, transfer directly to dL4 for Unix through the use of dL4 Term. These GUI features can also be used without using dL4. All of the terminal GUI functions are controlled by character sequences thus allowing any Unix application to produce and control a Microsoft Windows Look-and-feel user interface. For character oriented Unix applications such as "vi", the GUI terminal model includes all necessary character terminal functions such as cursor positioning, line insertion/deletion, and protected characters.

dL4Term can be installed and used on any Windows 95, Windows 98, or Windows NT 4.0 system that supports telnet (TCP/IP) connections to UNIX and many other hosts.
